## **COMING EVENTS**

- July 3rd (Friday): Fairview Shopping Center will be having a "funny-money" auction from 6:30 to 8:30 pm. From 7:30 to 8:00, however, the "funny-money" will be set aside and valuable items will be auctioned for real money to benefit the depot project.
- 4th of July (Saturday): This is the annual Independence Day celebration at Stow House, sponsored by the Goleta Valley Historical Society. A wide variety of entertainments are planned, including Gramma's Attic. The Depot Quilt will be on display and tickets will be available.
- July 10th (Friday): There will be a special get-together of Friends of the Depot and their guests from 7-9 pm at the Goleta Library. Committee members will be on hand to answer questions and the full set of architectural drawings will be available for viewing. Please plan to attend.

DEPOT COMMITTEE ORGANIZATION The Goleta Depot Committee was set up in 1980 by the Board of Directors of Goleta Beautiful Inc., a local nonprofit organization, to locate a new site for the depot and to prepare a plan for its restoration and rehabilitation. The committee includes representatives from the Chamber of Commerce of Goleta Valley, the Institute for American Research, the Goleta Valley Historical Society, and the community at large, as well as Goleta Beautiful itself. Its membership includes architects, cultural resource specialists, planners, historians, civic leaders, railroad enthusiasts, financial experts and dedicated citizens. All project sub-committees are organized under the Depot Steering Committee: Gary Coombs (chair), George Adams and Ray Baird.

REVIEW COMMITTEE The Review Committee is responsible for overseeing the restoration/rehabilitation process and protecting the integrity of the depot as an historic structure. Most importantly, the Review Committee has prepared a set of "Guidelines for Restoration and Alteration", which incorporate guidelines for Santa Barbara County Landmarks and buildings on the National Register of Historic Places. Members are: Gene Allen, Ray Baird, Barbara Cornish and Karen Swenson.

PHOTOS NEEDED Old photographs of Goleta Depot are crucial to the restoration effort but are also extremely rare. Neither the Goleta Valley Historical Society nor the Santa Barbara Historical Society, for example, have a single picture! Southern Pacific and the News-Press have provided copies of two valuable photos but the Review Committee needs to hear from anyone else who has such photographs. DEPOT SITE In February, the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors approved the Depot Committee's plan to relocate the depot at Los Carneros Park, on a site immediately west of the historic Stow House. The depot plan calls for the use of landscape screening to aid in preserving the ranch atmosphere of the Stow complex. Water for the depot will be obtained through a cooperative agreement to share water between Goleta Beautiful, the Goleta Valley Historical Society and the County.
