DEPOT FRIENDS MEETING Don't forget! Friday, July 10th, 7-9 pm, Goleta Library. Let's get acquainted!

STOW HOUSE BARBEQUE The barbeque at Stow House on June 6th was a big success. A good time was had by all and over \$400 was generated for the depot project. The Goleta Valley Historical Society deserves special recognition for sharing the proceeds from this annual event with us.

TARGET DATE SET The Depot Committee has set the month of October as its target date for moving the depot to the Los Carneros Park site. With \$34,000 in cash or kind still needed to complete Phase 1, the Fundraising Committee needs to bring in roughly \$2000 each week until October to meet this goal. With everyone's help they can do it!

I WANT THE DEPOT TO STAY RIGHT WHERE IT IS. WHY MOVE IT? If we had a dollar for every time we've heard this, Phase 1 might be complete! It is really a very important question, of course, and it deserves a detailed answer:

When the Depot Committee was first formed, its members strongly favored leaving the depot at its natural site, if this were at all possible. Accordingly, efforts were made to acquire the property from the Kellogg Heirs Association, the property owners. Subsequently, the Depot Committee was told, both by the Association's president and by its attorney, that the property was not for sale and that the depot building could not remain there. Instead, the Kellogg heirs offered the building to Goleta Beautiful, on the condition that it be moved to another location. Reluctantly, the Depot Committee turned to other alternatives and after much searching, the Los Carneros Park site was found and approved.

QUILT NEARS COMPLETION The Goleta Depot Quilt is now nearly finished. Designed by Marilyn Romine and Kelli Greene of the Institute for American Research, the quilt contains twenty different designs based on the traditional pinwheel theme. The quilt is entirely handmade, representing the handiwork of 18 volunteers. Previewed to acclaim at the Stow House Barbeque, the quilt will be displayed at various valley locations, including H and H Country Store, which donated the fine cottons and batting used.

The drawing for the quilt will be held on October 15th. Tickets are available for a \$1 donation at the Institute for American Research, Chamber of Commerce and display locations. If you would like to help with the final quilting, please call Marilyn (964-5598) or Kelli (964-1325) after 5 pm. A large frame or easel is also needed for display purposes.
