LAWN SALE UPDATE A number of organizations and individuals contributed to the success of the August 23rd Lawn Sale and deserve special recognition. These include: N and M Catering (Nancy Reid and Mary Lou Williamson), Goleta Girls Club, MacDonald's-Goleta, Goleta Lemon Association, Goleta Center 4-H, Goleta Valley Community Center, Santa Barbara Sound Quartet (Brent Anderson), Channel City Chorus and the Goleta Valley Historical Society. Thanks to everyone who gave us a hand!

**LEASE APPROVED** As expected, the Santa Barbara County Board of Supervisors approved the lease agreement with Goleta Beautiful on August 31st. Incidentally, the parcel of land that will serve as the depot's new home is approximately 1.6 acres in extent.

**WATER PERMIT GRANTED** On Thursday, September 3rd, the Goleta Valley Water Board approved the permit that will allow Goleta Beautiful and the depot to share water with the Historical Society and Stow House. Although much still needs to be done in other areas, this represents our last major **administrative** hurdle.

GRADING TO COMMENCE Ray Baird, Chairman of the Facilities Committee, reports that we should have our grading permit from the County by September 15th. The grading should be completed in the next two weeks. South Coast Contractors, Inc will be doing this work for us, as their contribution to the project. This represents a substantial monetary savings!

FUNDING UPDATE Approximately 77% of the Phase 1 goal has now been raised. Major additions over the last two weeks include 32 cubic yards of concrete, valued at over \$1300, for the building foundation. Contributors were Goleta Ready Mix, Southern Pacific Milling Co, McNall Building Materials, and Granite Construction Co. Ten yards are still needed to complete the foundation.

**IN-KIND NEEDS** The project still needs a number of other in-kind donations of labor and materials including: window glass, carpentry, foundation work, plywood, roofing materials and labor, plumbing fixtures, wiring and electrical work. **KEY DEPOT PROJECT PARTICIPANTS** Two additional organizations that have been actively involved in efforts to save the depot are the Goleta Valley Chamber of Commerce and the Goleta Valley Historical Society.

The Goleta Valley Chamber of Commerce is a nonprofit corporation founded in 1950. The object of the Chamber is to promote the economic, civic and social welfare of the people of the Goleta Valley and the County of Santa Barbara.

Current Chamber President **George Adams** is Chairman of the depot fundraising drive. The Chamber organized the All-Aboard Party in March and the Chamber's offices have also served as the headquarters for project information and sales of tickets and t-shirts.

Now located in the Far West Savings Building at 5902 Calle Real, the Chamber is interested in locating its offices in the depot after it is moved and restored.

The **Goleta Valley Historical Society** was founded in 1966 and has a current membership of over 200. The historical society was the community organization which initiated efforts to save the depot back in the early 1970s.

While Goleta Beautiful has now taken a leading role, the historical society continues to actively support the depot project. The organization not only shared the proceeds from its annual BBQ with the project, but has also made that most precious of Goleta Valley commodities - water - available to the depot through a cooperative agreement with Goleta Beautiful. George Adams has also represented the historical society on the Depot Steering Committee.
