**NOVEMBER BARBEQUE ANNOUNCED** Goleta Beautiful is planning a Santa Maria-style barbeque to be held on Sunday, November 8th. Hours, place and ticket information will be announced in the next **Dispatch**.

**TITLE TO BUILDING OBTAINED** At long last, we have received written title to the depot building. Representatives for both Southern Pacific and the Kellogg Heirs Association signed the agreement which makes Goleta Beautiful sole owner of the structure.

**FACILITIES UPDATE** Ray Baird, Chairman of the Facilities Committee, reports that the site grading work should be completed by the end of September. Go out and visit the site (300 No. Los Carneros Rd) and see what you think.

The soils test indicated the presence of expansive soils at the site, which will require some minor adjustments to the foundation design. A middle-to-late October moving date is still scheduled, however. Some of you may have seen a newspaper report that the building would be moved on September 24th. This was incorrect.

**DISPATCH SWITCHES TO MONTHLY SCHEDULE** Beginning with our next issue, the **Depot Dispatch** will be published on a monthly rather than a bi-weekly basis. This will allow us to spend more time taking care of our depot.

**FUNDING UPDATE** \$20,000 is still needed to complete Phase 1. Of this amount, approximately \$4,000 must be in cash. The remainder can be in the form of contributions of labor and materials.

MAJOR IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS RECEIVED Our lease with the county requires that during the construction/restoration period there must be a chain link fence surrounding the depot. This will serve to protect both the building and children who may be playing in the area. We are very fortunate that Larsen Fence of Goleta has donated the use of fencing during the construction. This represents a savings to the project of over \$500 and we are most grateful to Jim Froelicher for his help in obtaining this contribution.

Mid-State Roofing (Bob De Barge) has generously donated felt roofing paper, flashing and all roofing labor.

Other major in-kind contributions include soils testing, performed by Pacific Materials Laboratory, and site surveying by Hugh Simpson. Thank you very much for all of these valuable donations.

Morning Press, in a section entitled "Goleta Personals", reported that "The gospel has been brought to Goleta. (emphasis ours) This would seem to be clear evidence for a 1901 construction date. Remember, however, that "depot" may refer simply to the site and not the building itself (see the Depot Dispatch, Vol. 1, No. 6).

Walker Thompkins tells us (personal communication with Steve Sullivan) that the depot was built over the winter of 1901-1902, and finished during the early months of 1902.
