HAPPY NEW YEAR ONE AND ALL And with the new year we inaugurate the second volume of the **Depot Dispatch**. Who would have guessed that we'd make it this far?

FUNDING UPDATE Goleta Beautiful has been awarded a grant of \$5,000 from the **Santa Barbara Foundation**, for use on the depot project. This is another major step toward completion of Phase I, for which another \$10,000 is still needed.

BRICKS, WINDOWS AND DOORS are selling like hotcakes! Over 130 bricks, ten windows and two doors have been sold so far. Prices are \$5, \$40, and \$150, respectively. Remember, the bricks you get to keep - the doors and windows are contributions to the depot which will bear plaques commemorating the donor.

If you've visited the depot lately, you've noticed that the windows and doors have all been removed (except for the freight doors). They are in the process of being repaired and restored. **Gene Allen** is in charge of seeing that the doors are taken care of; **Mike Glassow** is coordinating the window project.

IN-KIND CONTRIBUTIONS The following companies have generously donated primer paint to be used on the depot exterior: Santa Barbara Paint Factory (10 gallgants) is Fazzo ePaint and Wallcoverings (10 gallons), and Aten's (20 gallons). You will recall that the painter's union (District Council of Painter's #52) will be donating all of the painting itself. This is a savings to the project of thousands of dollars! Thank you all.

GOLETA DEPOT -- AN EXCURSION INTO THE PAST is the theme of the 17th annual Goleta Valley Night Feb. 27, a dinner-dance at the Elks Lodge, at which the 34th annual presentation of the Goleta Valley Golden Deed Award will be made.
