FUNDING REPORT January proved to be a super fund-raising month. Over \$5,000 in cash and in-kind contributions were generated during the month for the depot. Much of this money came from the sale of doors, windows and bricks. Only \$3,000 is needed to complete Phase 1 of the project, which includes restoration of the depot exterior.

As of February 1st, there are only three doors and 16 windows left to be sold.

BUILDING UPDATE Work on the new sewer system, which will serve Stow House and the fire station as well as the Depot, is currently in progress. Our old friend, South Coast Contractors Inc., is doing the work. Foundation and structural repair work are still being delayed by the wet grounds.

Mike Glassow and Bob Hiestand report that the windows have all been stripped of their original paint and the repair work has now begun. Restoration of the doors has also been started. Ralph Moore and Ernie Thomsen are assisting Gene Allen in this project.

REVIEW COMMITTEE The Restoration and Review Committee has decided that the exterior of the depot will be restored to the period circa 1915. One of the main reasons for this decision is that we have two excellent photographs taken during this period by Southern Pacific. Thanks are due to **Steve Sullivan** for acquiring one of these photos for us.

LAST CALL FOR VALLEY NIGHT The deadline for making reservations to Goleta Valley Night is Friday, February 19th. Call Phyllis Olsen at 964-3008 if you would like to sit with other Depot Friends. The theme this year for the February 27th event is **Goleta Depot - An Excursion Into The Past** and proceeds will go to the depot project.

MUSEUM REPORT A number of items have been donated to the project for eventual display in the Depot Museum. These include a beautiful station clock, donated by **Roger Levenson**, two switchman's lanterns from **Nancy Ried**, an oil can and other items, from **Allan Baisley**. We will also be receiving several pieces of 1930-vintage dinnerware from a Southern Pacific dining car.

The second "Goleta" sign, from the depot exterior, has also been recovered!

Gene Allen (967-2095) is serving as temporary curator for these items until the Museum is ready to accept them.
